

ORDINANCE 2012-58

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE MILLAGE RATE OF 1.6630 FOR THE TOWN OF MALABAR FOR THE PERIOD FROM OCTOBER 1, 2012 THROUGH AND INCLUDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2013, PROVIDING FOR REPEAL AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, public hearings as prescribed by Florida Statutes have been duly held in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Town Council, in regular session duly assembled adopted the millage rate of 1.6630, to be levied for the General Fund upon all real and tangible personal property located within the boundaries of the above named taxing authority.

SECTION 2. The final levy of 1.6630 mills will result in a 0.0116 decrease to the rolled back rate of 1.6746.

SECTION 3. This final millage rate of 1.6630 is to fund the expenses for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2012 and ending September 30, 2013.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. In the event a court of competent jurisdiction shall hold or determine that any part of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder shall not be affected and it shall be presumed that the Town Council of the Town of Malabar did not intend to enact such invalid or unconstitutional provision. It shall further be assumed that the Town Council would have enacted the remainder of this ordinance without said invalid or unconstitutional provision, thereby causing said remainder to remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption after the second public hearing.

This ordinance was moved for adoption by Council Member Beatty and was seconded by Council Member Acquaviva and, upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
