Proclamation
Town of Malabar,
Florida**

Whereas, the Town Council of the Town of Malabar expressed their gratitude to the many individuals and businesses that donated time and material to the Beautification of the front yard of the Malabar Town Hall at the Council meetings of May 7 and May 21, 2012; and


