

**RESOLUTION 07-2007**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA; RELATING TO PARTICIPATION IN THE CONFLICT RESOLUTION PROCEDURES INITIATED BY BREVARD COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 04- 182 initiating the conflict resolution procedures as set forth in Chapter 164 of the Florida Statutes concerning a request that the Town participate in the Law Enforcement Municipal Services Taxing Unit (MSTU); and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners subsequently adopted Resolution 07-036 again initiating conflict resolution proceedings due to the prolonged period of time since the adoption of Resolution 04-182; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined by the Town council that participation in the subsequent conflict resolution proceedings are warranted.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Malabar, Brevard County, Florida that:

**Section 1.** The Town of Malabar hereby expresses its desire to participate in the conflict resolution proceedings.

**Section 2.** All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**Section 3.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
