

RESOLUTION 15-2009 - FAILED

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING GREEN BUILDING STANDARDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAJOR RENOVATION OF TOWN BUILDINGS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 255.2575, Florida Statutes, established the importance in promoting the construction of energy-efficient and sustainable buildings; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council agrees that government leadership in promoting these standards is vital to demonstrate commitment to energy conservation, saving taxpayers money, and raising public awareness of energy rating systems.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF MALABAR OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA that;

SECTION 1. The Town Council hereby finds that energy-efficient and sustainable building design, construction, and operation furthers the goals set forth in the Town's Strategic Plan, including the Vision of an attractive beautiful Town.

SECTION 2. All municipal buildings shall be constructed to meet at least one of the following, the United States Green Building Council Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design rating system, the Green Building Initiative's Green Globes rating system, the Florida Green Building Coalition standards, or a nationally recognized, high-performance green building rating system as approved by the Florida Department of Management Services.

SECTION 3. All municipal buildings undergoing major renovation, where the proposed work meets or exceeds fifty percent (50%) of the current value of the building will be designed and constructed in accordance with one of the above mentioned standards as far as practicable.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon the enactment date.

This Resolution was moved for adoption by Council Member Rivet. The motion
