

RESOLUTION 41-2014

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO A BUDGET ADJUSTMENT IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS OF RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is necessary from time to time to adjust the amounts in various line items within a department and to record adjustments approved by Council and to accurately reflect the departmental expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF MALABAR OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA that;

SECTION 1. Amend the Budget Amount in General Government (519) Department.

Transfer from and to the Accounts indicated on the attached Budget Transfer Authorization to accurately record the revisions to the General Government Department.

SECTION 2. Amend the Budget Amount in Legal (514) Department.

Transfer from and to the Accounts indicated on the attached Budget Transfer Authorization to accurately record the revisions to the Legal Department.

SECTION 3. Amend the Budget Amount in Fire Control (522) Department.

Transfer from and to the Accounts indicated on the attached Budget Transfer Authorization to accurately record the revisions to the Fire Control Department.

SECTION 4. Amend the Budget Amount in Parks and Recreation (572) Department.

Transfer from and to the Accounts indicated on the attached Budget Transfer Authorization to accurately record the revisions to the Parks and Recreation Department.

SECTION 5. Conflict

All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
