

**RESOLUTION 26-2015**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MALABAR, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN CLERK AND TOWN ADMINISTRATOR TO DELETE DEPT 539, PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AND MOVE THOSE EXPENDITURES INTO DEPT 541, STREETS AND ROADS AND DEPT 519, OTHER GENERAL GOVERNMENT SERVICES TO MORE ACCURATELY REFLECT WHERE THE EXPENDITURES ARE BEING UTILIZED; PROVIDING FOR AN AMENDMENT TO THE BUDGET AS OF JANUARY 1, 2016; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, Based on the Department of Financial Services Uniform Accounting System the Town Clerk and Town Administrator are requesting the authorization to eliminate Department 539, Other Physical Environment from the Town Budget. Those expenditures should be carried under Department 541, Streets and Roads or Department 519, Other General Government Services. The Town Clerk has confirmed with the outside auditors that this would be an appropriate change.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF MALABAR OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA that;**

**SECTION 1.** Amend the Budget as of January 1, 2016 to eliminate Other Physical Environment (539) Department.

**SECTION 2.** Amend the Budget as of January 1, 2016 to allocate those expenditures into the more appropriate Other General Government Services (519) Department Amount in Streets and Roads (541) Department.

**SECTION 3. Conflict**  
All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4. Effective Date.**  
This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.


This Resolution was moved for adoption by Council Member Vail. The motion was seconded by Council Member Kohler and, upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


