Hans asked if there were any additions or changes to the agenda, Liz said the 2/10/16 Minutes will not be ready, she got the wrong tape.

No Minutes

D. Discussion:

1. LOCAL TALENT LINE UP:

Hans confirmed that Swamp Fox will be the main band; Doug Hoyt said that a purchase order was issued and Bruce Marion (Swamp Fox) has confirmed. Hans said that this band (Swamp Fox) will provide all the equipment & MC for the day.

Hans discussed local talent playing for half hours segments during the main band breaks.

Laura said that she has a commitment from the youth band from Brevard Worship Center. Laura suggested that the local talent have a sign-up sheet for "open mic".

Hans and committee discussed the time that the main band (Swamp Fox) is going to start and finish, then discuss when there will be "open mike", or Karaoke, etc.

The following was discussed:

- Main Band (Swamp Fox) to start at 11:00AM, Hans said normally the band plays for 4 hours. Liz suggested that the band play 2 hours, and then break for "open mike" to fill in. Grant suggested for the band to play one (1) hour then break and fill in with the local talent & "open mike" and then play another (1) hour, etc. Doug said this would be no issue with Bruce Marion to play and break for "open mike".
- Doug said we have a written confirmation from Bruce Marion and outline of what he is supposed to do. Laura suggested maybe to ask Bruce, he already does "open mike" night and how he runs that so locals can play. Doug said that Bruce anticipated playing about 3 hours and the "MC" and the go-to "MC" for announcements.
- Laura suggested to Doug to ask Bruce for advice on how to incorporate our local talent and other bands throughout the day, should a list be made up that day or sign up before.
- Hans said the actual time that will be cover by band, "open mike", and "MC" will be 11:00AM to 4:00PM.
- Liz & Laura discussed that the band will be set up before 10AM, for the opening ceremonies and make announcements.
- Doug was going to ask about what kind of equipment Bruce was bringing, for maybe karaoke
- Grant/ Hans talked about a guy named "Ken" doing Karaoke.

Hans asked committee about when to schedule the next Springfest Committee meeting. The committee consensus is: **next meeting is set for March 24, 2016 @ 6:00PM.**

Hans suggested contacting Debby or Doug with anything that comes up. Hans asked Doug to email what Bruce's suggestions are for signing up open mike sessions throughout the Springfest day.

Hans summarized that we know the times for that band is and what the band is going to do. Doug is going to find out the sign up process for "open mike".

Hans asked if Debby had any update on this.

Hans handed the above donations to Denine to give to Debby Franklin. Hans asked Denine about and update on Sponsorship and Denine responded about FPL and Waste Management had made donations. Hans asked about Hometown News? Denine was not aware of anything with Hometown News.

Hans talked about the verbiage for FIT radio site (Public Service Announcement); he said they (FIT) like it two weeks before the event. We can now announce the Band. Hans will send this to Debby for review.

Liz and committee are reviewing the Springfest flyer; the Lure Chasing- Swift Paws by Meghan is not listed on flyer. Liz asked Doug about sheep herding, he responded that Joanne is out of town that week.

Doug said the Lure Chasing is in the Mail Boat. Laura said the West Indian food for Rickie is not listed. Laura was going to check on another person in Town for sheep herding.

3. VOLUNTEERS FOR EVENT:

Hans said a lot of young people from Trail Life & American Heritage Girls will be volunteering. The next Springfest Meeting is March 24, 2016 @ 6:00PM.

Mayor Crews asked Hans about giving an update of Springfest events at the March 21, 2016 Council Meetings, and he (Hans) said he would.

Ritter asked Drew Thompson or Bob Wilbur if they wanted to do a trail ride on bicycles. Grant Ball said trails are great right now. The committee discussed the different trails.

Ritter suggested about one of the committees (Trails & Greenways or Park Board) doing a bike trail ride having t-shirts and charging a little money (money can go towards trail maintenance) Annalee said she will ask Drew. Ritter said everyone liked the 5K and the t-shirts so the trail ride is just an idea.

Denine told committee about the neon colored t-shirts that were ordered to sell at Springfest 2016.

Hans asked about "Staff" t-shirts, Denine said Debby is taking care of that.

Hans suggested about the balloons at the specific booths, that our late Mayor Beatty suggested the different colors for different booths.

Laura/Liz suggested green for where the money is, and red for the ticket booths, and blue for something else, etc.

Annalee/Grant suggested having a booth for the Town Representatives, Council, Boards, and Committees so that residents or visitors can ask questions or introduce themselves and explain what the specific functions each representative does. Each Committee should have a member present sometime throughout the day. Laura said last year the Teen Council had a tent near Dick Korn's tent (two 10' x 10' tents) located near large pavilion. Mayor Crews suggested having members sign up for one (1) hour intervals to man the tent.

Mayor Crews suggested about the "next door Malabar" social media network having a booth set up so people know who they are talking to, and maybe have a banner and have people sign up and communicate with other people from Malabar. Hans suggested a 10' x 10' tent for Malabar people to meet and greet.

Denine suggested doing produce at the Springfest.

Hans asked about the minutes from the last meeting. Hans said at the next meeting all the minutes will be reviewed.

Hans will ask the Park Board & Trails & Greenways about members committing an hour at Town Tent to represent that Board/Committee. Liz will ask the Planning & Zoning Board. Grant will ask Council Board. Annalee suggested setting up a display about the history of the Town of Malabar. Laura said this was done last year at Springfest. Annalee said Trails & Greenways can get some handouts for the trails. Mayor Crews said there are some display Boards about the "Old School House". Liz suggested having some maps for public to see.

Hans said he will ask Murry Hanns about trail rides so people can see the trails.


4. GENERAL INFORMATION UPDATE:

D. Discussion:

Doug suggested that two weeks after the event to get together and have a recap to go over what went right and what went wrong, determine if any money was made, and start next event 8-10 months before the event day with more volunteers. Rickie agrees.

- How Many Vendors? (Dorothy said about 20.)


Rickie discussed the car raffle and the Town will make money.
