1. Approval of Minutes
Regular Trails & Greenways (T & G) Meeting – November 9, 2015

5. Waterfront Triangle at N. end of Rocky Point – Rocky Point Issues

Discussion: Richard Green, 2680 Rocky Point Road, came forward to speak regarding this issue. In this situation, he is very disturbed over it. He's been there since 1976; home broken in 3 times and his kayak stolen. He is against having this non-motorized boat ramp brought into the Rocky Point S/D. He stated to go to the south of Rocky Point. Bob Wilbur, Hans Kemmler and Drew Thompson spoke to Mr. Green's concerns. Kelley stated that all the minutes are available on line as well as the audio of the meetings now. If people don't have the availability of the internet, they are more than welcome to come to Town Hall to read the minutes for any and all boards/committees.

6. TOM T&G Committee / EEL Program Signage Coordination

Discussion: Hann gave an overview of the signage coordination with the EELs Program. The committee is happy with how the signage planning is taking place. The next idea is to put some stuff out there and try it out.
